

Sheep Pasture Program Offerings

The following programs are all designed to provide a unique hands on educational experience for any students pre-K through 6th grade.

GROUP VISIT PROGRAMS

Incredible Insects

60 minutes

What are the characteristics of insects? Catch a few insects to understand their physical traits and those of other small critters found in the wild. *Life Science Strand*

Herpetology Program

60 minutes

What are the characteristics of amphibians and reptiles? How are they different from us? Come have your students meet our resident Box Turtle and other Herps! *Life Science Strand*

Sensory Exploration

90 minutes

Come explore the natural world, utilizing all five senses. This program is great for younger students. *Life Science Strand*

Fresh From the Farm

90 minutes

Did you know almost everything in your pantry and refrigerator came from a farm? Meet the animals, join in activities, and experience the daily life of a farmer. *Life Science and Technology/ Engineering Strand*

Wampanoag Culture

90 minutes

How did the Wampanoag Indians live hundreds of years ago? What kinds of tools did they use? What kinds of foods did they eat? Come listen to stories, handle artifacts, and learn about their culture. *Social Science Strand*

Amazing Adaptations

90 minutes

How do organisms survive? What does it mean to adapt? What's the difference between a worm and a salamander? Come learn about the superhero adaptations of the animals at Sheep Pasture and see how many of them we can find! *Life Science Strand*

Our Furry Friends

60 minutes

What makes a mammal a mammal? What separates mammals from turtles and frogs? Come explore the animals that live here at Sheep Pasture to find out! *Life Science Strand*

Habitats Program

90 minutes

Come explore three of Sheep Pasture's unique habitats. What sets them apart from each other? What kinds of animals live in each one? Come learn this and more. *Life Science Strand*

Predator and Prey

90 minutes

What does it mean if an animal's eyes are on the front of its head? What about on the side? Come learn about the complex relationships between producers, consumers and decomposers. *Life Science Strand*

IN SCHOOL PROGRAMS

Butterfly Busybodies

60 minutes

How is a butterfly different from other insects? What do they eat? Come learn the unique attributes of these beautiful creatures with hands-on activities. Great lesson for younger students. *Life Science Strand*

Whale of a Lesson!

60 minutes

What makes a whale a mammal? Come walk through a life-sized model of a blue whale, explore its unique adaptations, and discover some of the special features of its environment. *Life Science Strand*

Seasonal Animal Homes

60 minutes

Students will learn how animals make their homes and how they utilize them during the different seasons by acting out parts in a fun animal play. *Life Science Strand.*

Owl Pellet Detectives

60 minutes

What do owls eat? Unleash your inner biologist and get ready to dissect your own real owl pellet to find out! *Life Science Strand*
