

Group Visit Program Offerings

Incredible Insects

60 minutes

What are the characteristics of insects? To answer this and other questions we will go out and catch a few insects to understand the physical traits of insects and other small critters found in the while. *Life Science Strand.*

Herpetology Program

60 minutes

In this program we review the characteristics of amphibians and reptiles, and introduce the children to a few. *Life Science Strand.*

Sensory Exploration

90 minutes

This interactive program is an introduction to the natural world utilizing all five senses. This program is great for young children. *Life Science Strand.*

Fresh from the Farm

90 minutes

This program makes direct connections between our food, the products we use, and where they come from. Loads of farm-related activities and visits with farm animals make this class unique. *Life Science and Technology/Engineering Strands.*

Wampanoag Culture

90 minutes

We will learn about the way native people survived in this area through the use of artifacts and stories. A focus will be placed on their tools, the food they ate, and how they lived. *Social Science Strand.*

Amazing Adaptations

60 minutes

How do organisms survive? Can they change to fit an environment? We will go over the definition of an adaptation and find some living examples in the outdoors of sheep Pasture. *Life Science Strand.*

Our Furry Friends

60 minutes

By using many of the animals that live here at Sheep Pasture we will figure out the answer to the big question: What makes a mammal a mammal? *Life Science Strand.*

Habitats Program

90 minutes

We will go over what constitutes a habitat and visit three different habitats here at Sheep Pasture. By focusing on a few organisms we are able to further the students understanding of the habitats. *Life Science Strand.*

Predator and Prey

90 minutes

This program focuses on the dynamic relationship between predator and prey and the connections between producers, consumers and decomposers. *Life Science Strand.*

Butterfly Program

60 minutes

60 minutes

Students will learn how animals make their homes and how they utilize them during the different seasons by acting out parts in a fun animal play. *Life Science Strand.*

Owl Pellets Program

90 minutes

What does an owl eat? Students will become biologists and dissect their own owl pellets. *Life Science Strand.*
