## **Sheep Pasture Photography Session Guidelines**

To maintain an environment which is safe for our visitors, photographers, and their clients, the NRT has put in place these session scheduling guidelines for photographers. Guidelines are subject to change without notice, based on the latest guidance. We appreciate the cooperation of all of our photographers and their guests as we work to keep Sheep Pasture safely accessible to all.

Due to COVID-19 regulations, NRT of Easton is requiring that all photographers interested in scheduling a professional shoot at Sheep Pasture MUST meet the following guidelines:

- 1. All photographers must hold a current NRT photography membership before scheduling dates. If they do not, memberships can be purchased from the NRT website:

- 2. Photographers must schedule sessions between the hours of 7:00 AM and 4:00 PM, Monday through Sunday. To allow for multiple photographers to use the more popular areas of the property in a day, sessions may not last longer than 90 minutes and must finish by 5:00 PM. Sessions are not available on holidays.
- 3. Photographers must contact NRT to schedule sessions and give NRT at least 48 hrs notice. A maximum of 3 photographers per day will be scheduled at the discretion of NRT. Appointments are not valid until NRT has officially confirmed date(s) and time(s) with photographers by email. Please print the confirmation email you receive and bring it with you on your scheduled day. Staff members may request to see confirmation emails from photographers who are on site.
- 4. Photographers are expected to maintain a list of client contact information for contact tracing purposes.
- 5. Photographers may not set up on or block: walking trails, at the entrances to buildings, or trail paths. Photographers may also not bring props (small signs, handheld items are acceptable).
- 6. If a scheduled photography session needs to be rescheduled due to weather or other adverse conditions, please contact Tristan Hayes at <a href="mailto:thayes.nrt@gmail.com">thayes.nrt@gmail.com</a> to reschedule. Appointments do not automatically transfer to the next day.
- 7. Disclaimer: Due to the ever-evolving COVID-19 guidelines, NRT reserves the right to cancel appointments at any time. Scheduled photographers will be notified by email as soon as possible if there is a change that may impact their date. Updates will also continue to be posted on the NRT's home page and photographer resource page.
